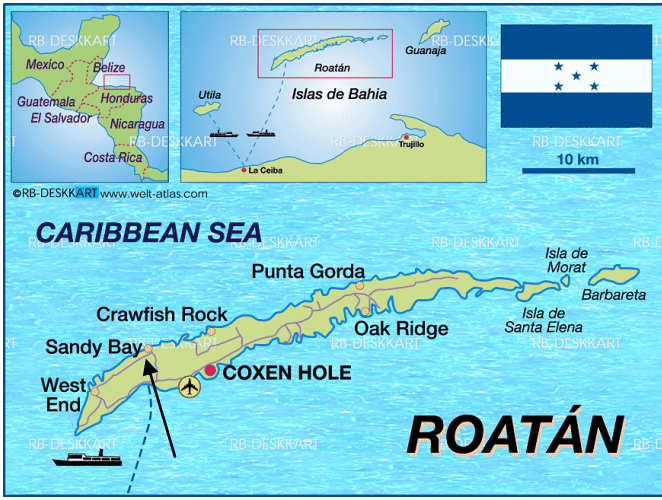


Missions Adventure to Roatan, Honduras
